RELAY FOR LIFE

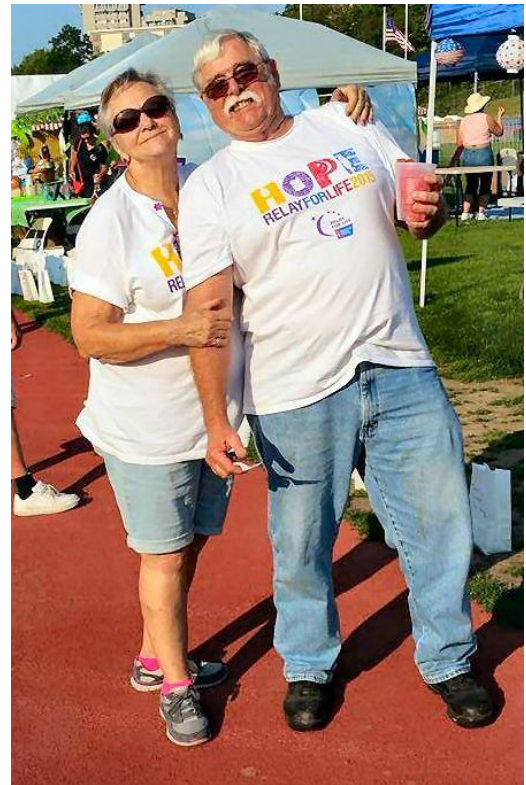
Dear Legion Members,
